INDIVIDUAL MEMBERSHIP BENEFITS

Training & certification in all areas of production

Members are eligible to be trained and certified in a wide variety of media skills. Members must become certified in each area before signing out or using applicable LPCTV equipment.

Access to LPCTV equipment, studio, and channel time

Members, once certified, may use and sign out any piece of LPCTV equipment on a first come, first serve basis.

Produce programming for Channels 8 & 10 and the web

Member-produced programming is given priority on the TV Schedules. Members may request timeslots based on the content of the programs. Training is also provided in the area of new media uses and distribution.

Technical assistance with all areas of production

Members have complete access to technical assistance through all literature and staff resources available at LPCTV. Staff is available at all times during LPCTV operating hours to lend technical assistance to members.

Access to official training courses, as made available by LPCTV

Members have first choice for all media production courses offered through LPCTV. Additional professional training may become available through outside sources. Members will have access to any of this training as it becomes available to LPCTV.

Promotion of programming by LPCTV

LPCTV will publicize all programming on the "Program Schedule" section of LPCTV's website. Producers may request additional publicity for special programs and the launching of series programs.

Voting privileges

By being a member, you have the right to affect policy and change. At all times, members are encouraged to provide feedback on LPCTV operations. LPCTV will occasionally poll its membership on various issues; some will be put to a membership vote. Members are eligible and encouraged to vote for LPCTV Board of Directors and on items presented prior to the LPCTV Annual Meeting.

Candidacy for LPCTV Board of Directors

LPCTV encourages its members to run for office. Members may, and should, seek seats on the LPCTV Board of Directors.
