Shall the voters of the Windsor Central Modified Unified Union School District approve the merger of Barnard School District with Windsor Central Modified Unified Union School District, pursuant to the Articles of Agreement?

ARTICLE 3

If Article 2 is approved, shall the voters of the Windsor Central Unified Union School District approve the school board to expend Twenty One Million Seven Hundred Eighty Three Thousand Nine Hundred Forty Eight Dollars (\$21,783,948), which is the amount the school board has determined to be necessary for the ensuing fiscal year, of which Sixteen Million Eight Hundred Ninety Six Thousand Eight Hundred Thirty Three Dollars (\$16,896,833) is to be funded with taxes? It is estimated that this proposed budget, if approved, will result in education spending of \$18,673 per equalized pupil. This projected spending per equalized pupil is 2.82% higher than the combined spending per equalized pupil by Windsor Central Modified Unified Union School District and Barnard School District for the current year.

ARTICLE 4

If Article 2 is not approved, shall the voters of the Windsor Central Modified Unified Union School District approve the school board to expend Twenty Million Six Hundred Seventy Six Thousand Five Hundred Twenty Nine Dollars (\$20,676,529), which is the amount the school board has determined to be necessary for the ensuing fiscal year, of which Fifteen Million Six Hundred Sixty Eight Thousand Nine Hundred Fourteen Dollars (\$15,668,914) is to be funded with taxes? It is estimated that this proposed budget, if approved, will result in education spending of \$18,754 per equalized pupil. This projected spending per equalized pupil is 3.27% higher than spending for the current year.
